When I discussed the problem of arsenic recovery in Toronto recently, it was agreed that our plant capacity will not be increased until some method of improving our arsenic recovery is found. It was also agreed that our present methods would not be replaced by anything radically different unless a substantial improvement in arsenic recovery resulted.

As I told you, in our conversations at Giant, we plan to add scavenger processes to our present plant that will not affect the operation of the cottrell plant.
