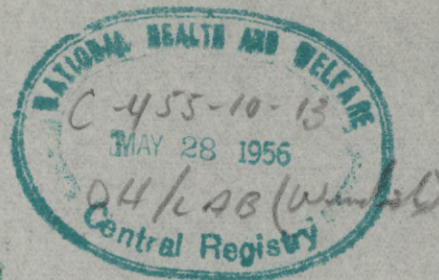

I enclose a copy of our chemist's memorandum on the four aqueous samples of arsenic which you sent. Please note that he has reported the contents as milligrams of As₂O₃ per millilitre of solution.

Regarding the samples which we sent to you, our sample C was reported as containing 0.075 milligrams of Arsenic per liter. This should read, 0.075 mg. of As₂O₃ per liter. Samples A and B are correctly reported as As.

We hope to hear from you soon to compare results.
