My prediction that we would experience a slight rise in Arsenic content following the rainstorms, May 23 to 27 has not been borne out, rather, these figures indicate that the water is continuing on the downward grade.

Lake waters have been behaving in a most erratic fashion and I have held off reporting them until I had some assurance that the trouble was not in the determination. I am now satisfied on this point and believe the erratic figures are due to a peculiarity of the run-off.
