Reference is made to your letter of September 25 concerning the delay in installing Cottrell equipment at the Giant Yellowknife. This will mean that large quantities of arsenic will continue to be deposited in the area, and I can only repeat the apprehension which we have expressed in the past. I hope that every effort will be made to have this equipment in operation as soon as possible.
