
Dear Mr. Monkman:

I have your letter and the write-up on methods which you so kindly prepared. Many thanks.

To further check our procedures I am sending to you by express a box containing six samples taken in the Yellowknife area. Will you please make arsenic determination on these?

I have not as yet received a figure on these from our laboratory but from the location I would expect them to be in the order of .05 to .15 mgs As/L. I am anxious to establish a standard technique and will appreciate greatly if you can give these specimens early attention.
