
Dear Mr. Pitcher:

The results for the second group of waters are as follows:

<u>Sample</u>	<u>Arsenic, mgms. As per litre</u>
1 - 1	0.20 ✓
1 - 2	0.96 ✓
1 - 3	0.93 ✓
1 - 4	0.38 ✓
1 - 5	0.28 ✓

Without knowing the source of the samples, etc, it would look as though the arsenic content were slightly higher than in the ones reported on July 26th. Do corresponding numbers in the two cases indicate samples from the same location?
