Replying to your letter of January 3rd.
It appears to me that the recommendations of the
Department of National Health & Welfare as outlined in
your letter are rather drastic. I shall wait until I
receive Dr. Charron's letter before deciding whether

that the N.W.T. Council has modified the recommendations.
I shall advise the Local Trustee Board of the
recommendations at the first meeting after I receive
them. After studying the recommendations I shall decide
whether I can make a trip to Ottawa to discuss the
problem and let you know date of arrival.
