Arsenic at Yellowknife

Referring to our Tuesday conversation, and the attached confidential Yellowknife report which was completed today, I think this matter should be considered urgent.

My associates on the Yellowknife expedition felt we were a committee which would report formally to R. A. Gibson. May I have clarification as to whether the Department wishes this to be the procedure which I find was first mentioned in a letter of November 16 from R.A.G. to G.D.W.C.

I might say that my associates as of Friday last did not entirely share my views on the subject. However, yesterday Mr. Traill phoned and indicated that he and Mr. Parsons felt the companies should proceed to install the conventional equipment without further delay. He suggested a meeting.
