I am most grateful to you for your several communications during past weeks and have been withholding reply until I had had the opportunity of visiting Yellowknife again and firming up a plan I had in mind for carrying out a survey with a party at Yellowknife. It now appears that the Industrial Health Laboratory will be sending a party to Yellowknife during the fall to do both an environmental and biological investigation. I will be sending you details of this at a later date and would hope that we might continue to be in a position to draw upon your specialized knowledge of the field and, indeed, hope that we might count on your being in Yellowknife at the time of the survey. Meanwhile, may I suggest that we continue with the sampling according to the current plan and make a decision as to future work by Con on the occasion of our visit to Yellowknife which is apparently coming up.
