Dear Dr. Kay:-

In view of your interest in the problem concerning the collection and disposal of arsenic from the roaster operations of the mines at Yellowknife and in the meeting held in my office on the lst of June, 1951, to discuss this general problem, I am sending you herewith, a copy of a letter by Mr. Raht to Mr. W.G. Jewitt, Manager of Mines, Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company of Canada Limited, Trail, B.C., calling attention to certain items in the minutes of the meeting which he considered to be inaccurate.

Mr. Raht's letter contains valuable comments on the question of the contamination of Pud, Kam and Rat Lakes, and is, altogether, a most useful contribution to the study of the control of arsenic pollution in the Yellowknife area.
