

SUBJECT: Phone call from Mr. Gibson re arsenic, Yellowknife

A letter is coming from them asking us to send one or two experts to assist them in a conference with the Manager of the Giant Mine. It will be requested that those who go have authority to sign a statement in writing regarding the health hazards of the arsenic.

This is to ask you if you will go accompanied by Dr. Charron, if you wish, and to authorize you on my behalf to sign any document which, in your opinion, is required to impress the mining people with the gravity of the danger and the necessity for immediate and effective action.
