Dear Doctor Kay:

This will acknowledge and thank you for your letter of October 18th. You were right in inferring that the sample numbers referred to a definite sampling location. I am enclosing a map showing the sampling locations. The one in red prefixed by the numeral 1 are water samples and those in green prefixed with the numeral three are vegetation samples.

We are making one change in the water sampling. Previously, samples 1-1 and 1-2 were taken from Baker Creek with a relatively short distance between them. We have decided to discontinue the sample 1-1 and will be taking a sample marked 1-6 which will be a sample of our tap water.
