

Dear Clare:

I am enclosing a copy of a letter which I have just written to Doctor Kay, with regard to cutting down on the frequency of arsenic determination in Con and Yellowknife domestic water. I think this letter is self-explanatory but, Doctor Kay, in his letter ~~today~~, asked specifically that we resume weekly tests about the middle of April. The object of my correspondence with Doctor Kay was to relieve your laboratory so much as possible during this period when the arsenic content is low. You may decide that you would prefer to continue the weekly tests, but since we have Doctor Kay's concurrence in my suggestion that we could cut back, I would be content to leave the matter in your hands.
