We had not forgotten the matter of reducing winter water sampling points raised originally by you in a letter of February 12th and again on June 7th. I was waiting to have a meeting with the North West Territories group. That meeting was held on May 28th and it was decided that the Rat lake, Frame lake and one Kam lake point might be dropped during frozen conditions. I had been intending to communicate this decision to you within a few days.

The matter of once-monthly sampling will be reviewed in July on the occasion of our summer visit to Yellowknife. We will notify you of our intended date of arrival.
