With reference to the continuing survey of arsenic roaster fumes in the Yellowknife area, analysis of samples collected during the past summer indicates that investigation will be necessary for another year in order to provide a clear indication that the arsenic laid down in the area is disappearing at a satisfactory rate. We would therefore require a further sum of \$2,000.00 to assist in covering cost of work during fiscal year 1953-54.
