Itinerary - Jack Windish.

Tomorrow after lunch I shall leave for St. Cesaire, P.Q. While there, I shall stay at "Au Foyer des Hirondelles" telephone 813 or 140 W. I expect to collect one sample of blood from O. Pelletier in Abbotsford Wednesday morning then go to Frelighsburg to gather information from three growers on their spray programs of this past summer.

I shall leave for Ottawa Thursday morning, stopping on the way to collect blood from A. Thomson at Macdonald College in Ste. Anne de Bellevue.

This Sunday, November 30th, I shall fly to Edmonton where I shall stay at the Airlines Hotel. I hope to complete by Monday evening the necessary preliminary arrangements for the shipping of the laboratory apparatus which we have stored there, so that I can fly to Yellowknife Tuesday morning. After completing the sampling program in Yellowknife, which will take about a week, I shall return to Edmonton to supervise the packing of the lab. equipment. On the way back I hope to be able to stay in Winnipeg for 2 or 3 days on stat. leave. Probably I shall be back in Ottawa by December 15th.
