



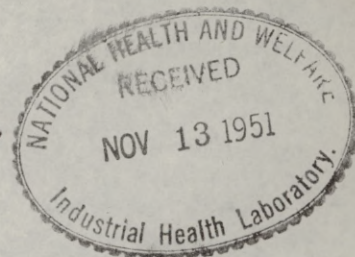

Dear Dr. Kay:-

I have for acknowledgment, your letter dated the 25th of October regarding the environmental arsenic survey to be conducted by your Department this Fall. For your information, we are providing a sum of \$2,000.00 for the Estimates in 1952-53. We have asked the Northwest Territories Council to provide \$2,000.00 towards the survey to be conducted this Fall. Of course, you will realize that until this expenditure is approved by the Northwest Territories Council at its meeting to be held in Yellowknife on the 11th of December, 1951, this money will not be available.

I am advising Mr. Homulos and Mr. Bishop, by copy of this letter, that you expect to arrive in Yellowknife the 20th of November with two assistants to commence the survey. Mr. Homulos will work in close cooperation with you and your assistants, and it is possible that Mr. Russell, who has been taking periodic samples, will also be able to assist you in the performance of your survey.
