Re - Arsenic Survey -Yellowknife, N.W.T.

Referring to your letter of November 18, your File 455-10-13, it is regretted that our letter of November 13 gave you the impression that the sum of \$54.80 of the \$2,000 provided in connection with the above mentioned survey had been expended by officers of your Service. Actually this expenditure was incurred by Dr. O. L. Stanton, Medical Officer of Health, Yellowknife, in connection with advertising in the local press regarding arsenic poisoning hazards and sealers required for water samples. These items were considered to be a legitimate charge against the amount provided for the arsenic survey.
