#### FIRE

### IMMEDIATE ACTION INFORMATION

#### GENERAL:

- Keep unnecessary people away.
- Keep upwind.
- Isolate hazard area.
- Wear self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective clothing.

#### FIRE:

**Small Fires:** dry chemical or CO<sub>2</sub>.  
**Large Fires:** water spray, fog or foam.  
Move containers from fire area if without risk.

#### SPILL OR LEAK:

**Eliminate** all ignition sources.  
Do not touch spilled material.  
Stop leak if without risk.  
Use water spray to reduce vapours.  
**Small Spills:** take up with sand, earth, or other non-com-  
bustible absorbent material, then flush area with water.  
**Small Dry Spills:** shovel into dry containers and cover,  
then flush area with water.  
**Large Spills:** dike for later disposal.

#### FIRST AID:

Remove to fresh air.  
Call emergency medical care.  
Remove contaminated clothing and shoes.  
If not breathing, give artificial respiration.  
If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.  
In case of contact with material, immediately flush skin or  
eyes with running water for at least 15 min.  
Keep patient warm and quiet.  
Effects of contact or inhalation may be delayed.
