

## Arrival of an Arsenic Trioxide Bulk Hauler - Instructions to Security

The following are a brief set of guidelines we would appreciate your following upon the arrival of a Trimac bulk Arsenic Trioxide hauler:

1. Issue both drivers with hard hats and safety glasses.
2. Give the driver an instruction sheet and then escort the truck around to the loadout silo. This is necessary to prevent a driver from accidentally trying to drive under the tailings pipeline trestle.

3. Loadout hours of operation are between 08:00 and 20:00 hours. If the truck arrives within these hours please phone over and inform the mill shift boss of the truck's arrival.

If the truck arrives outside these hours then offer to take the drivers down to the Giant staff house. Room numbers 22 and 24 have been reserved for their use and is equipped with towels to allow the drivers to shower. The key to this room is kept in the security gatehouse.

If they decline your offer remind the truck drivers that they should not under any circumstance take the trailer portion of their truck into Yellowknife. This is a requirement of both the N.W.T. government and the city of Yellowknife. The loadout operator will supply any fuel they require after they load. If necessary they can unhook and leave the trailer parked over at the loadout facility.

4. When the loaded truck is ready to depart please collect the hard hats and safety glasses that were issued to both drivers upon arrival.
5. After the truck departs please call the R.C.M.P. at 920-8311 and inform them that a truck load of arsenic trioxide has departed the Giant minesite heading south.
6. After the truck passes the N.W.T. - Alberta border they will be calling security to inform you that they have left the N.W.T. Please call the R.C.M.P. at 920-8311 and inform them that the truck load of arsenic trioxide from the Giant mine has now cleared the N.W.T. highways system.
